During this time, she created music for more than 100 documentaries, about 30 feature films and TV series. As well as music for several cartoons.

From 2000 to 2004, Marina won several prestigious all-Russian competitions for composers, and became a laureate in the nominations for the Best Academic Instrumental and Vocal Music, she became the winner of the improvisers' competition and received a special prize from the Union of Composers of Russia.
